I, *Margarita Maga de Suroy* do solemnly swear that I am a subject of *Mexico* that I have never become or been a Citizen of the United States, by naturalization or otherwise, nor have I declared my intention to become such Citizen; that I have never held any political office, nor voted at any political election in the United States, nor done any act in derogation of my allegiance to *Mexico*.

I DO FURTHER SOLEMNLY SWEAR, that so long as my Government remains at peace with the United States I will do no act, nor aid, advise or consent that any be done, nor conceal any act done or to be done, that shall aid, assist or comfort any of the enemies or opposers of the United States, or the authority or Government thereof.
